Long Term Priority Plan Lowell School District

- 1. Security
- All doors Replaced and less visible form Hallways
- Secure perimeter with Rod Iron fencing in order to create on entrance only
- Visitor Parking out in front of school
- If possible relocate offices with better proximity and vision to the front door.
- Electronic Locks on front door
- 2. Modernize and renovate Interior of Both Schools
 - Drop ceilings and replace lighting.
 - Resurface every wall to cover led paint. Place tact board on all walls.
 - Mount projectors on ceilings along with screens an updated technology
 - Every Classroom has teaching walls. 4 feet of cabinet along the bottom of the wall. Rolling whiteboards with storage behind.
 - Replace asbestos flooring with Red and black Carpet in High School.
 - Renovate all sinks and bathrooms / locker rooms to make ADA accessible. Update flooring.
 - Break down wall that separates coat room from back room to expand the size of middle rooms.
- 3. Replace Lowell Gym
 - Turn current high school gym into multi-purpose room with bleachers that pull out for auditorium seating.
 - Wrestling Room with low ceilings
 - Renovate Lundy Gym
- 4. Remove existing wrestling room and portable classroom building and replace with a new wing of 6 classrooms (replacing wrestling room, math room, special education room, add a fitness center/weight room).
- 5. Addition of a preschool/kindergarten complex of four classrooms
- 6. Pay off outstanding district loans
