Half of a Sped Directory, a high school teacher and two elementary teachers. These investments over the 23-24 school year allowed us to make progress towards our Outcomes and Strategies. We are extremely proud that every one of the attending seniors graduated on time and all of our freshmen were on track to graduate. We saw improved elementary attendance last year.</p>

Our plans this year include a school counselor, additional administrator, dean of students, and more teachers mean smaller class sizes to improve communication and relationships.</p>
