As most of you are aware, we are busy planning for our Jr/Sr high school students' return to in-person instruction. Lowell Jr/Sr High will be utilizing a hybrid model, Monday through Thursday, with half of the students in the classroom while the other half will be distance learning. Each week, the students, who are divided into A/B cohorts, will switch. If you have a student attending LHS and have not received an email regarding the hybrid schedule and cohorts, or a phone call from transportation, please call the office at 541.937.2124.

Much of this year has brought guidance, requirements and regulations that we are promptly trying to meet in order to maintain the safety and health of our students and staff. One such requirement is having on site Covid testing of students available. Testing could be administered due to two scenarios: if a student exhibited Covid symptoms while at school or was exposed to Covid while at school. Parental consent is required to test students. Parental consent forms will be sent out Tuesday, February 16th. Please sign and return if you would like your child to be tested if they are exhibiting symptoms at school or have been exposed to Covid while at school. You have the option of opting out of testing. Please remember, whether you choose to give permission for testing or opt out of testing, if your child is sick with any symptom, they need to stay home for their health and the health of others.

Monday, February 15th is President's Day and there will be no school. Please enjoy the long weekend!

This year, we are unable to hold our Kindergarten Round-up and registration.
