- ✓ Home football fans will enter through the gate on Lakeview opposite the scoreboard. You must use only this entrance and not the athlete entrance.
- ✓ Stay in the area near the endzone closest to the gate. This is designated for home fans. State guidelines call for all spectators to be in designated areas only. They may not interact with athletes or fans from the away team.
- ✓ Please bring a chair or be prepared to stand, as there will not be bleachers provided at this time.
- ✓ Please present your ticket upon arrival. You will not be allowed to enter without a ticket. No exceptions. You may not leave and re-enter.
- ✓ All mask and social distancing guidelines will be enforced.
- ✓ Failure to follow these guidelines may result in removal from this and all future contests.
